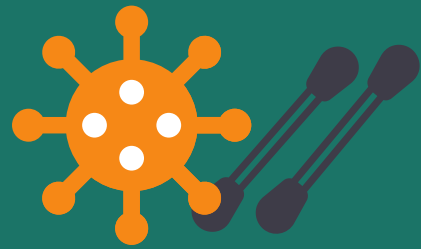


# COVID-19



## Who can and cannot be tested?

The state has broken down groups of individuals who may be tested into 3 priority groups so we can be sure we are testing those most at risk first. The COVID-19 pandemic is evolving quickly. Some people may experience aches and pains, nasal congestion, runny nose, sore throat or diarrhea.

### PRIORITY ONE



Hospitalized patients



Any type of symptomatic healthcare facility workers

### PRIORITY TWO



Symptomatic patients over age 65 years



Symptomatic first responders



Symptomatic patients with underlying conditions



Symptomatic patients in long-term care facilities, or any congregate living arrangement

### PRIORITY THREE



Symptomatic critical infrastructure workers



Asymptomatic health care workers and first responders



Individuals with mild symptoms

### PRIORITY FOUR



Asymptomatic critical infrastructure workers who have been exposed to COVID-19; only test if there is capacity
