

I want to be vaccinated!

I submitted the form but I don't know if you got my information?

If you see a screen that says, "Thank you. We have recorded your information" and provides further instructions, we received your information. You will not necessarily receive an e-mail or phone call until we have new appointments available. On April 5th, anyone over the age of 16 will be eligible to receive a vaccine. Please note that even if you successfully schedule an appointment, if we don't get the vaccine, your appointment may be canceled or rescheduled.



I received a link to schedule an appointment but there are no appointments available. Is my link broken?

No. This means there are no appointments available for your priority group at this time. You can continue to check this link for cancellations, and watch your e-mail for additional appointments and vaccination locations. Appointments will be added.

When I'm looking for an available appointment, it says "more times", but when I click on it, none are available, even months from now!

Given how unpredictable vaccine supplies are at this time, we are only planning a few weeks ahead. We will be adding more clinics as quickly as vaccine supplies allow. You can also continue to check the schedule to see if an appointment opens due to a cancellation. Additionally, multiple people may be trying to schedule the same appointment at the same time. Unfortunately this is due to a software limitation.



I have filled out the form for my elderly loved one, but they do not have an e-mail address or internet access. How will you make sure they get a chance to schedule?

We will be reaching out by phone to those who do not have e-mail to schedule appointments directly. Because this is hundreds of people, it will take us some time to reach everyone. Alternatively, you may put in your own e-mail in on your relative's behalf.

I couldn't get through to the health department by phone. I left a voicemail but no one has called me back.

Please e-mail covidvaccine@bedhd.org and we will respond as soon as we can. We are trying our best to both answer the phone directly as well as return messages. People are leaving new messages faster than we can return them.



Will you be offering clinics in places other than Lansing and Hastings?

Yes, some off-site clinics are being planned. We will share additional locations via e-mail when available. You can schedule in any location in either county.

Thank you for your patience and understanding. The population that can be vaccinated is very large. As vaccine supplies increase, and more places are able to start providing vaccinations, more appointments will be available.
